"Opportunities for play and creativity are few and far between in a landscape of uncertainty. The few spaces that remain more often than not fall to those who have the resources to seek them out and to access them" says Georgina Densley, Participation Director of Travelling Light.

"With children increasingly facing issues such as poverty, hunger and housing it is easy to forget that in addition to their basic needs, children also deserve to play, create and imagine - these things are also crucial to their wellbeing. Our Yes Let's Appeal aims to raise £50,000 to invest in childhood, and the opportunity for children to make, be part of and experience great stories, putting the creativity back in to childhood in Barton Hill, across Bristol and beyond".

"Our campaign will run From 1 May - 31 August" continues Georgina, "during this time every £1 raised will be matched £1 for £1 in money from Arts Council England's Catalyst Fund. Giving us the potential to double our target and raise an amazing £100,000"

"Each year we work with over 28,000 children and their families in Bristol and across the UK through workshops, performances and festivals – our Yes Let's Appeal will enable us to ensure that these families can continue to benefit from exciting creative experiences. Even more key though is that funds raised by the appeal will enable more resources to be invested in providing space to play, create and share stories for children with the least opportunity to seek them".

"We are asking the public to join us in our Appeal – raising funds whilst having fun. From running a cake sale, watching a film or taking part in our Yes Let's Day (18^{th} July), Yes Let's Picnic week (12^{th} Aug – 18^{th} Aug), or just donating directly to the appeal – every contribution counts!"

The game Yes Let's is a well-known drama game that children play at Youth Theatre. It involves one person announcing an activity eg: 'Let's be Butterflies' and everyone replying 'Yes! Let's!' and taking their lead. The activity can be switched at any point when another player over rides them with the phrase 'Let's stop' and

following with another suggestion 'Yes Let's dance'. The game ends when 'Yes Let's Finish The Game'.

If multiple schools took part we could have the world's biggest game of Yes Let's!
